

## “What hinders Prayer” Part 3

### Proverbs 1:22-28

God is repeatedly in this passage offered reproof and wisdom, yet the reproof and wisdom was ignored. It was never taken to heart or even budged. It is not that they were completely defiant or disobedient to what God was saying, rather they were simply indifferent. It did not matter one way or the other. Because of indifference, God says that: ‘When your fear cometh as desolation and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you. Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me:’

To God, making no choice is just the same as choosing against Him. If we are indifferent to God’s reproof and instruction, then we too can be sure that when we call upon God He will not answer us or be found!” Imagine going through a hard time and not being able to even find consolation through pray. That is the effect indifference will have on our life!

Lord, me you remove the spirit of indifference from our life. May we remember that no response is the same as a response in the negative! Help us to always be willing to learn from and apply your reproof and instruction in our life so we may have an open communication line with you!
