# Furlough

As many have read in the last prayer letter, our family will be coming back on our first furlough. We will arrive back in the US on the 2nd week of June 2012. Please pray with us as we have many decisions and plans to make over the next 4 months.

We need to find a place to store our belongings, secure some form of transportation while in the US, decide what we will do for housing while on furlough, and get new prayer cards, presentation, letterhead, and a display together.

We are trying to decide whether we will rent an apartment, purchase a 5th wheel, or live between hotels and prophets chambers. If you know someone who has a 5th in good condition that they are trying to sell, please let us know. Also, if your church has a prophet's chamber or mission's apartment that we could use for a time, please let us know that as well.

At this time, our schedule looks as follows:

1. June through September in the Northeast
2. October through December in the South
3. January through March in the West
4. March through May in the Mid-West & South
5. June back in the Northeast until we depart for Australia.

I am currently in the process of contacting each church to schedule a time to report about the ministry here.

Please also pray that we will be able to raise an additional \$2000/month in support during this furlough. Since we arrived in Australia almost 9 years ago, the exchange rate has gone from US \$0.61 to AU\$ 1.00 to US \$1.08 to AU \$1.00.

We look forward to seeing everyone in the coming months to personally share what God is doing here and thank you for your faithful prayer and financial support!
